Her albums and singles have reached the top of many charts and her live performances have been viewed by millions. Jana is much more than just an accomplished musician. An important part of her life is her role as motivational speaker for Native American youth. It has led to the founding of her own organization, Jana's Kids, whose mission is to provide youth with the resources and inspiration to achieve success in their lives. Her Native American Motivational Presentation, a combination of music, dance, and motivational speaking, has become the most successful youth-oriented presentation of its kind in the country.
