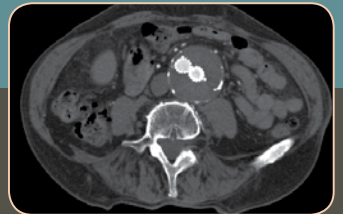
## Course Objectives

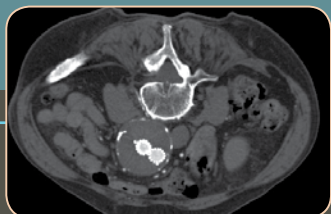
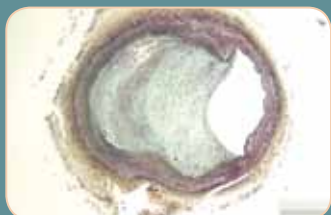
