Registration and Cancellation

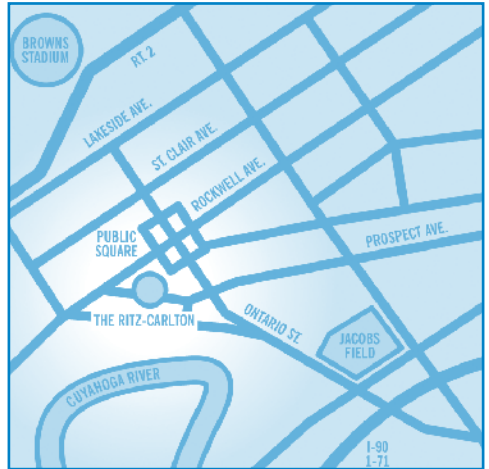
