## **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

This is a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  day course which will provide a high-level overview of many topics related to professional development for surgeons in early training. Specifically, there will be a strong emphasis on challenges that disproportionately affect women trainees, and strategies for navigating those challenges. Faculty will consist of a dynamic and relatable group of surgeons from across the country who are experienced in these areas. Attendees will have the opportunity to interact with the faculty in a friendly and casual environment both at the conference and at the accompanying events, while also meeting their peers and colleagues from around the country.

### **LEARNING OBJECTIVES**

After completing this educational activity, the participant will be able to:

- Gain understanding of challenges pertaining to women surgeons in training and strategies to address those challenges
- Have an introduction to the concept of professional development, including some strategies for being a successful resident, planning future career directions, and learning how to give a well-received presentation
