This annual course is designed for busy clinicians looking for an opportunity to enhance their declarative and procedural knowledge in the field of immunology, as it applies to patients with immune mediated inflammatory diseases. The course begins with an initial remedial update on advances in immunology for the non-immunologist. Our next session addresses hot topics in immunology, including RMP, GCA and Seronegative RA, impaired gut barrier, and immunologic insights into ILD in SOJIA and Still's Disease. We will cover new treatments in PsA, SpA, complement and vasculitis, lupus, and SAPHO. Our faculty will deliver a round-up of issues related to COVID and rheumatology/immunology, including vaccines, long COVID, and cytokine storm. Finally, we conclude our program with a keynote presentation exploring wellness and COVID-19.

The symposium is directed to rheumatologists, dermatologists, infectious disease clinicians, allergists, clinical immunologists, and specialists in integrative medicine, preventive medicine, wellness, primary care and other health care professionals caring for patients with immunologic diseases.
